Over the last 10 years or so, a plethora of new primary legislation has been enacted, or revised, covering all aspects of information technology and the digital world we now live in. This brings up various key issues for the employer. For example, what they can do if they catch an employee tampering with or misusing company computers. Laws such as the Human Rights Act (1998) and the Computer Misuse Act (1990) have a direct bearing on these issues and the workplace. Not only do companies need to review their IT security, but also consider adding addenda to employment contracts to make it clear what employees can and cannot do on company computers. This one-day course will explain and examine current legislation and how it affects your business so that you are better prepared to protect yourself, and your company profits, against any potential civil or criminal claims.

Legislation covered will include

- The Computer Misuse Act (1990) as amended by the Police and Justice Act (2006)
- The Data Protection Act (1998)
- The Human Rights Act (1998) including EU directives
- The Privacy and Electronic Communications (EC Directive) Regulations (2003)
- The Telecommunications (Fraud) Act 1997
- The Fraud Act (2006) as adapted for the digital age

The course will also cover topics such as phishing, identity and credit card theft, forgery, spam, piracy and intellectual property frauds, extortion, denial of service and data interception.

At the end of this course delegates will have a practical understanding of current law affecting computers and information technology as applied to the workplace, particularly in respect of employees rights, and also how to safeguard your company if you need to carry out any in-house forensic investigations, due to suspicious activity or misconduct.
